Privacy policy

Welcome to our website. Thanks for your interest in our company. To settle any concern you may have about how your personal data is used, we clearly set out how we use any data collected and what security measures we take. Information is also provided about your legal rights in relation to the processing of this data.

Personal data

We do not usually require any personal data from you when you visit our website. We are only provided with information about the name of your Internet service provider and the pages you visit on the OSCAR DAFFE website. However, you as an Internet user remain anonymous because we only analyse this information for statistical purposes (for example, the number of hits for individual pages).

Personal data is only collected if you provide it voluntarily, for example when - using the contact form to submit a query

Use and sharing of personal data/limitations on use

All personal data that we obtain from you during your visit to our website is only collected, processed and used for the stated purpose. This is only done in line with applicable legal provisions and where applicable only with your consent. You can of course revoke any consent provided at any time.

Right to information

On request, we can also provide you with written details of whether we hold any personal data about you and if so what precisely. You can also ask for your personal data to be corrected if necessary.

Principles of security

In order to protect the data we hold on employees, customers and suppliers against accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction or access by unauthorized persons, we have taken appropriate technical and

organizational measures. We work with security experts to continually check security levels and adapt them to new security standards.

Cookies

Several areas of our website use what are known as cookies. These are used to make our site more user friendly, effective and secure. Cookies are small text files which are stored on your computer and saved by your browser (locally on your hard disk).

These cookies can be used to establish the usage behaviour of our customers and therefore to continuously adapt the content of our website to users' needs. Cookies also allow us to gauge the effectiveness of a particular advert or the success of where articles are positioned on our website based on interest in particular benefits.

Most of the cookies we use are known as session cookies, which are automatically deleted after your visit.

Most web browsers accept cookies automatically. If you would prefer not to communicate this information, you can usually change your browser settings. However, website use may be limited as a result.

Use of Facebook social plugins

Our website uses social plugins from the social network facebook.com, which is operated by Facebook Inc., 1601 S. California Ave., Palo Alto, CA 94304, USA ("Facebook"). The plugins are identified by a Facebook logo or the words "Facebook Social Plugin".

When you access a web page containing one of these plugins, your browser connects directly with the Facebook servers. The content of the plugin is transferred from Facebook straight to your browser which automatically incorporates this into the web page.

By using plugins, Facebook can see that you have accessed a page on our website. If you are logged into Facebook, Facebook can link the visit to your Facebook account, even if you have not pressed the "Like" button. If you interact with the plugins, for example, by pressing the "Like" button or leaving a comment, the relevant information is sent from your browser directly to Facebook where it is stored.

Even if you don't have a Facebook account, Facebook can collect data about

you (e.g. IP address). Please refer to the Facebook data protection notices for the purpose and scope of data capture, further data processing and use of data by Facebook and your rights and options for protecting your privacy. If you do not want Facebook to collect data about you when you visit our website, you need to log out of Facebook before visiting us. You can also use add-ons to install blockers for your browser.

Google Analytics

This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google Inc. ("Google"). Google Analytics uses "cookies", which are text files placed on your computer, to help the website analyse how visitors use the site. The information generated by the cookie about your use of the website will be transmitted to Google and stored on servers in the United States. In case of activation of the IP anonymization on this website, Google will truncate/anonymize the last octet of the IP address for Member States of the European Union as well as for other parties to the Agreement on the European Economic Area. Only in exceptional cases, the full IP address is sent to and shortened by Google servers in the USA. On behalf of the website provider Google will use this information for the purpose of evaluating your use of the website, compiling reports on website activity for website operators and providing other services relating to website activity and internet usage to the website provider. Google will not associate your IP address with any other data held by Google. You can refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser. Google AdWords Conversion Tracking
